Organisation

The organisation must be flexible and efficient, and the management style is based on dialogue. Danisco Sugar's core tasks must be performed by our own staff for the purpose of ensuring our competitiveness and future development. This means that we may decide to outsource other tasks to external partners.

Danisco Sugar focuses actively on the potential of every employee and intends to use this potential in the best possible way.

Development

We aim to fill every position with an employee having the right personal and professional competencies. Recruitment and development are based on your competencies – not on gender, nationality, race, religion, etc.

Your competencies must be developed on an ongoing basis. Consequently, Danisco Sugar finds it important to develop your competencies to match the current challenges facing you and Danisco Sugar. You must therefore be prepared to accept new tasks, participate in project work across the company and complete training programmes and attend supplementary courses.

Danisco Sugar focuses strongly on your adaptability to change and your flexibility. You must also be able to speak and write English and use IT tools at a level matching your job requirements.

All employees have an annual appraisal interview where you and your superior talk about the issues that relate to Danisco Sugar, your development and your professional as well as personal challenges.

Communication

Confidence and development are key words in the dialogue between you and your superior in relation to professional as well as personal matters.
